Comments: Discontinued; manufacturer recommendations: ELISA; Preliminary experiments gave an approx. 60kDa band in lysates of HEK293, HeLa and HepG2 after 0.5µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the band we observe given the calculated size of 45.8kDa according to NP_671723.1. The 60kDa band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide. We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported? This antibody is expected to cross-react with the highly similar LASS6. ELISA.
