Comments: The ORF has no Stop codon. This design enables easy recombination into a destination vector to add an epitope tag of choice and Stop codon to the ORF. Do NOT use this plasmid directly for transfections. A set of 4 custom lentiviral vectors is available (pLX301 (<http://www.addgene.org/25895/>) , pLX302 (<http://www.addgene.org/25896/>) , pLX303 (<http://www.addgene.org/25897/>) , pLX304 (<http://www.addgene.org/25890/>)) to be used to express these ORFs in mammalian cells. These plasmids are not included in the kit and must be ordered separately.
