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Description: The Macromolecular X-ray Crystallography Facility at Iowa State University provides a Rigaku/MSO rotating anode generator for single crystal X-ray diffraction studies, training in crystallography techniques, and a computer lab equipped with crystallography software. Facility services are provided on a fee basis and include consultation on protein purification, crystallization, and crystal optimization, as well as assistance with crystal screening, data collection, data processing, and structure determination and analysis. The following outline is used for general planning of a crystallography project: Protein purification: concentrated protein > 95% pure
Crystallization: 3D, mountable crystals
Crystal screening: search for high quality, high resolution crystals
Data collection: using facility or synchrotron equipment
Structure determination: processing, phasing, refinement, modeling, analysis, deposition
