Description: Rattus norvegicus with name SHR/N-*cp* from RGD.

Species: Rattus norvegicus

Notes: The spontaneously hypertensive corpulent (SHR/N-*cp*) rat developed at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) is a congenic strain in which obese homozygotes {*cp/cp*} are characterized by genetic obesity, mild hypertension, hyper-insulinemia, and glucose intolerance. This rat strain was initially derived by mating a male Koletsky rat that was heterozygous for the corpulent gene (*cp*/+) to a female SHR rat of the Okamoto strain. A minimum of 12 backcrosses were carried out to eliminate the non-*cp* genes of the Koletsky strain. The obese (*cp/cp*) littermates develop glucosuria, proteinuria, and renal structural lesions resembling diabetic glomerulosclerosis. [Rat Resource and Research Center](#)
